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Home Study Procedures

In the event of closure: Teachers will set learning tasks and activities appropriate for your child's year group. They will set a mixture of on and off-screen tasks including extended writing, reading and project work as appropriate. Students will receive guidance, before the closure, about how to study at home. Parents will receive guidance on supporting your child to study at home.	
Setting work	Instructions for work will be set via Office 365. Your child will receive instructions by email at the beginning of each week (Mon/Tue) for the rest of that week.
Accessing the work	Students should follow the instructions sent by their teachers to access their tasks for the week. Teachers will use the method/s familiar to their particular classes which may include: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Attachment to email• Student Public Drive• Microsoft One Drive/Teams• Subject specific online platform There are some generic study support resources and useful websites at the back of the student planner.
Self-assessment/ answers	Where possible, teachers will provide mark schemes and answer sheets so that students can review their learning. Y11 and Y13 students may then e-mail their teachers with any specific queries arising. Other students should simply make a note of any queries to follow up with their teachers upon return to school.
If your child is stuck	If they are unable to proceed independently, please advise them to move on to another subject or task. A list of generic subject tasks will be available for students to access should they need alternative activities. They can follow up any problems on their return to school and should not become over anxious.
Y11 & Y13	All the tasks provided are there to support preparation for GCSE and A-Level exams and students should be strongly encouraged to use their time away from the classroom as productively as possible. Teachers are there to support them and students should be proactive in accessing this help during normal school working hours. It is our expectation that students contact their teachers themselves rather than parents communicating on their behalf. Any further information regarding exams will be posted on the school's website (via the blue i button at the bottom of the home page) as it becomes available.
