Staff/Students showing symptoms whilst on premises	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Staff and those students in school are invited to take part in the lateral flow test programme. There will be three tests undertaken at school for students, thereafter students are given lateral flow test kits to be undertaken at home twice per week. Staff have received guidance and a supply of lateral flow tests to be done at home two times per week. If taking part, only those testing negative will be permitted to attend school. If a positive test is produced, staff/students should obtain a PCR test. Anyone who displays symptoms should not come to school. Staff who become unwell, displaying Covid-19 symptoms (the main listed below) whilst at work are, required to leave school immediately if they are able to transport themselves home or isolated in A2S on A floor until collected. <p>Most people with coronavirus have at least one of these symptoms:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - high temperature – this means you feel hot to touch on your chest or back (you do not need to measure your temperature) - new, continuous cough – this means coughing a lot for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours (if you usually have a cough, it may be worse than usual). - loss or change to your sense of smell or taste – this means you've noticed you cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Students who become unwell will be isolated to A2S on A floor (with the window open) until collected. A bathroom on B floor (B17) has been identified for use for anyone who becomes unwell. This will be cleaned and disinfected after their use and before anyone else. If a teacher or student becomes unwell with COVID-19 symptoms, they should be sent home and should self-isolate for 10 days and be encouraged to get a test. Their fellow household members should self-isolate for 10 days. Staff and students informed to obtain a test and notify the school of the outcome.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Staff/students will not be allowed back to school until isolation is completed or a clear test result is obtained.
<p>Issuing care/first aid to staff or students</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No staff other than the First Aider or Healthcare Assistant should be involved in the care of students or staff. • Students will be asked to stand in the hallway outside the classroom in sight of the teacher until the First Aider/Healthcare Assistant arrives. • The First Aider/Healthcare Assistant should maintain 2 metre distance from unwell staff/student where possible. • The First Aider/Healthcare Assistant must wear a fluid resistant surgical mask, gloves and apron if 2 metre distance cannot be maintained. • If a person is coughing, spitting or vomiting safety glasses should also be worn or a face shield. • PPE will be available in the medical room. • The First Aider/Healthcare Assistant to be referred for testing if they have been in close contact with a person diagnosed with Covid-19 or if they display symptoms.
