Dear Parents and Carers

Y11 Results Day – Thursday 12th August 2021

GCSE examination results will be available for collection from school on Thursday 12th August 2021. We are hoping to run a normal results day for the students in order to share and celebrate their achievements. Due to possible restrictions on numbers permitted in the building, we ask that students pick up their results at the following times:

Surnames A–M **9.00 – 10.00 am**

Surnames N-Z **10.00 – 11.00 am**

School will also be open from 1.00 – 2.30pm for those that have not collected results in the morning.

If, however, the student or any member of the immediate household feels at all unwell or is isolating, please do not allow your son/daughter come in to school to pick up results.

We will, of course, abide by any government guidance still in place at the time in order to ensure that everybody is safe on our site and in our building. Staff will be around to guide and to advise students and parents of our procedures, as you arrive on the day but the following safety measures are likely to be in place:

- There will be no parking allowed on site. Please enter the site on foot, via the main or moor gates.
- Student access is restricted to the hall area only. In order to promote safe distancing we ask that parents wait for their child outside on the arena. If you have questions or need support then please ask a member of staff who will arrange this for you.
- There will be a requirement for students to use hand sanitizer and wear a face covering on entry to the building.
- Those needing support and advice (or access to IT) will be seated in family bubbles in classrooms surrounding the hall and staff will come to you to help.
- Finally, we ask that the celebration aspect (sharing results, taking photographs etc.) take place outside on the arena. We want students to be able to enjoy results day with their friends and family members but ask that everybody is sensible and considerate with respect to physical contact in order to reduce the Covid- 19 risks.

This year all students have a right to appeal their grades and details of the procedure for doing this can be found attached to this letter.

Important: On results day students will also be asked to complete a postcard, supplied in their results envelope, with details of their Post-16 choices. For those holding offers with the Crossley Heath Sixth Form, this card will act as confirmation of their decision to accept their place and it is vital that it is completed and handed in please. For those leaving us for other institutions or for employment, the card provides important information regarding student destinations.

If students are unable, or do not wish, to attend in person they should contact Mrs Collins (b.collins@crossleyheath.org.uk) by the 23rd July 2021 confirming the email or postal address to which results should be sent. Please be aware that we cannot give results to anybody other than the student or their parent/carer in person on the day.

Important: Students who are holding a place in our Sixth Form but who are unable to attend school on results day must confirm, on 12th August, that they will be returning to Crossley Heath in September. This is done by sending an email to Mrs. Pennington: (v.pennington@crossleyheath.org.uk)

Every year there are a small number of students who have not accepted an offer at Crossley Heath, who decide they wish to return. If this is the case, and the student meets all the relevant entry requirements, they should visit the Registration Desk on results day and tick the appropriate option on the postcard. Alternatively, they can also email Mrs. Pennington with their request to join Y12 by 3pm on results day. A member of the Sixth Form team will then get in touch with the student on the morning of Friday 13th August so they should expect an email or phone call.

I look forward to seeing all Y11 on results day and celebrating their achievements with them. It should be a very positive experience at the end of a highly unusual academic year.
