Dear Parents and Carers

Y13 Results Day – Tuesday 10th August 2021

A-Level examination results will be available in the Sixth Form block on Tuesday 10th August 2021 from 8.30am. This is later than in previous years as new Ofqual rules state that results cannot be released to students until 8.30am, which corresponds with the opening of the UCAS Clearing system. We are hoping to run our 'normal' results day for the students in order to share and celebrate their achievements. **If, however, the student or any member of the immediate household feels at all unwell or is isolating, please do not allow your son/daughter come in to school to pick up results.**

We will, of course, abide by any government guidance in place at the time in order to ensure that everybody is safe on our site and in our building. Staff will be around to guide and to advise students and parents of our procedures, as you arrive on the day, but the following safety measures are likely to be in place:

- There will be no parking allowed on site. Please enter the site on foot, via the main or moor gates.
- Student access is restricted to the Sixth Form areas only. Parents should wait outside, weather permitting, to avoid overcrowding. If you have questions or need support then please ask a member of staff who will arrange this for you.
- There will be a requirement for students to use hand sanitizer and/or gloves and to wear a face mask on entry to the building.
- Finally, we ask that the celebration aspect (sharing results, taking photographs etc.) take place outside. We want students to be able to enjoy results day with their friends and family members but ask that everybody is sensible and considerate with regard to physical contact in order to reduce the covid-19 risks.

As always, Mr. Coote (UCAS Coordinator), Mrs. Doig, Miss Rudman and many colleagues from across the school, will be available to offer congratulations but also to provide support, help and guidance with respect to the following:

- A Level Results
- Appeals
- University Admissions and UCAS Clearing processes
- Entry for the Autumn Series
- 'Next steps' decisions.

- A fully charged mobile phone and charger in order to make phone calls to university admissions teams
- All relevant UCAS information including login details, course details and offer details
- A copy of the relevant parts of their UCAS application including previous qualifications achieved (GCSEs, BTECs, EPQ, ABRSM exams etc.)

This year all students have a right to appeal their results and details of the procedure for doing this can be found attached to this letter.

If students are unable, or do not wish, to attend in person they should contact Mrs. Collins (b.collins@crossleyheath.org.uk) by the 23rd July 2021 confirming the email or postal address to which results should be sent. Please be aware that we cannot give results to anybody other than the student or their parent/carer in person on the day.

I look forward to seeing all Y13 on results day and celebrating their achievements with them. It should be a very positive experience at the end of a highly unusual academic year.
