Dear Parent/Carer

Your daughter has chosen to undertake the Sports Leaders Level 2 Award in her Physical Education lessons.

The award is a national recognised qualification that enables successful candidates to lead groups of people in sport/activity, under indirect supervision. The qualification teaches generic skills such as organisation, planning, communication and teamwork through the medium of sport. It is a fun and practical qualification with no entrance requirements or final examinations to sit.

The award consists of five units of work including five hours demonstration of leadership:

- 1. Developing leadership skills
- 2. Plan, lead and evaluate sport/physical activity sessions
- 3. Assist in planning and leading a sport/physical activity event
- 4. Lead sport/physical activity sessions. (5 hours of volunteering across two settings ie either 1 hour in School and 4 hours in the Community, or 1 hour in the Community and 4 hours in school.)

The award aims to develop students' generic leadership skills that will be vital in other areas of life. It is an excellent addition for students to include in their CVs in the future.

The cost of the award is £ 37.50 and when your daughter has completed the award, they will receive a certificate and will be a qualified Community Sports Leader.
