



Platinum Award – Leadership Activity Indicators

The following activities are examples of student leadership activities that can meet the gold award level. This is not an exhaustive list. Applicants should demonstrate a long term commitment to the Student Leadership Programme in order to gain the award. Applicants will strengthen the evidence they present to moderation if they have engaged in a number of these activities. Applicants must complete their Student Leadership Accreditation – Evidence Log and submit this for moderation in the Summer Term

(submission dates will be published by Mr Davis)

- Students' demonstrate an exceptional range of effective leadership skills that have had a sustained and positive impact on the school community over time
- Students' achieving the platinum level award will have already achieved the gold level award
- Students' achieving this level of award may be members of the student council or the 6th form student leadership team, although this is not an essential criteria
- The positive impact of leadership activities at this level will have been recognised by all stakeholders within the school community and beyond
