The cost of the Bronze Award is £263

£25.50 to DofE Charity for enrolment to the award; £237.50 to C I Adventures for administration, eDofE, expedition training and Assessed Expedition.

This is split into 3 payments on the parent pay system.

£70 payment by 8th February 2024 (non-refundable) £93 payment by 14th March 2024 £100 payment by 11th April 2023

What is included in the price:

- 2 training days and 2 days remote supervision on the Assessed Expedition
- Suitable sample food types for the Training Day (you will still need your own packed lunch)
- Loan of Group Kit (tent/stove)
- Gas (fuel) for the Assessed Expedition

What is NOT included in the price:

- Hire of personal kit: Waterproof Trousers/Rucksack/Coat/Sleeping Bag/Roll Mat/Hat & Gloves
- Boots: we recommend that everyone provides their own boots, something with ankle support and a decent grip on the sole
- Food for the Assessed Expedition
- Transport
- Camp fees for the Assessed Expedition (approx.£8.50 per person per night)

C I Adventures Camping Code of Conduct

Participants must:

- leave no trace
- be courteous of other campers
- abide by campsite rules, especially curfews
- sleep in their own allocated tent
- be in their own tent by a reasonable time, agreed by your team or supervisor
- not wander around the campsite at night

Participants must report (either directly, by phone or via campsite staff) to their supervisor if:
